### AGENDA

Citizens wishing to address the City Council may do so during the Public Comment portion of the meeting. Comments are limited to four (4) minutes per speaker. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the City Council may not discuss, deliberate, or take action on any matter not listed on the posted agenda. The Council may respond with a statement of specific factual information, recite existing policy, or direct staff to place a matter on a future agenda. Public comments on agenda and non-agenda items shall be made during the designated Public Comment portion of the meeting. Public comment will not be taken separately on individual agenda items unless otherwise required by law.

4. Consider and take possible action regarding the appointment of a Police Chief for the City of Frost. The City Council may convene in Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.074 (Personnel Matters) to deliberate the appointment of a public officer or employee and may return to Open Session to take any action deemed necessary.
5. Administer the Oath of Office to the newly appointed Chief of Police.
6. Adjourn

### NOTICE OF POSSIBLE EXECUTIVE SESSION

The City Council may convene in Executive Session in accordance with Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, on any matter listed on this agenda for which Executive Session is authorized by law, including but not limited to Sections 551.071, 551.072, 551.073, 551.074, 551.076, 551.087, and other applicable provisions of Chapter 551.


Any final action, decision, or vote regarding a matter discussed in Executive Session shall be taken in Open Session as required by law.
