Discuss, consider, and take possible action on Ordinance No. 339 adopting revised Chapter 13 (Utilities) of the Code of Ordinances; approving Exhibit A; providing for the continuation of existing utility regulations; providing for references to utility fees established by separate ordinance; providing for the preservation of existing authority; providing for repealer, severability, codification, and an effective date.
7. Discuss, consider, and take possible action on Ordinance No. 340 adopting the City of Frost Utility Fee Schedule; consolidating the City's utility rates, deposits, connection fees, reconnection fees, solid waste fees, utility taxes, and other utility-related charges into a single fee schedule; providing definitions; providing for administrative corrections of billing errors; providing for future amendments; providing for preservation of existing authority; providing for repealer, severability, and an effective date.

Discuss, consider, and take possible action on Ordinance No. 341 amending Chapter 14 (Zoning) of the Code of Ordinances to complete the relocation of certain zoning and land-use provisions previously removed from Chapter 4 (Business Regulations); adding Sections 14.02.021 and 14.02.022 relating to alcohol regulations and sexually oriented businesses; renumbering certain existing sections; and providing for codification, severability, repeal of conflicting ordinances, and an effective date.

Discuss, consider, and take possible action on Ordinance No 342 amending Chapter 14 (Zoning) of the Code of Ordinances to create Article 14.03 (Temporary Uses) and relocate certain garage sale and public dance provisions previously removed from Chapter 4 (Business Regulations); and providing for codification, severability, repeal of conflicting ordinances, and an effective date.

Consider and take possible action on Resolution No. 200 authorizing implementation of the Paystar customer payment portal, activation of the ACH automation module within the City's RVS utility billing software, replacement of the City's current Xpress Pay payment processing system, approval of associated expenditures, and authorization for the mayor to execute documents necessary to complete implementation.
11. Discussion and possible action for the engagement of a certified public accountant to perform the City's FY 2025-2026 annual audit.
