## **Code Corner: Animal Ordinance**

Friendly reminder for all pet owners — the City's animal ordinances help keep our community safe and comfortable for everyone.

Here are a few key points:

- Number of animals: No person or household shall keep or harbor more than four
  (4) animals of the same species at any one residential location. A litter under four
  (4) months of age is not counted toward this limit.
- **Enclosures:** Animals must be kept in **secure, sanitary enclosures** that prevent escape and protect against weather.
- **Animals at large:** It's unlawful for any animal to **run loose** off its owner's property. Pets must be restrained or on a leash when outdoors.
- Care: Owners are responsible for providing adequate food, water, and shelter at all times.

Let's all do our part to be responsible pet owners and good neighbors!

### **Frost Facts**

On May 6, 1930, a tornado struck Frost, destroying many buildings and tragically leaving 41 people dead. The event was later commemorated in the song "Frost Texas Tornado Blues" by Texas Alexander and the Mississippi Sheiks, recorded on April 9, 1934, in San Antonio, Texas, on the Okeh label.
