RESOLUTION NO. 201

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FROST, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CITYWIDE GARAGE SALE WEEKEND TO BE HELD DURING OCTOBER 2026; WAIVING THE GARAGE SALE PERMIT REQUIREMENT ESTABLISHED BY CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE DESIGNATED EVENT; PROVIDING THAT PARTICIPATION IN THE CITYWIDE GARAGE SALE WEEKEND SHALL NOT COUNT TOWARD THE ANNUAL LIMIT OF GARAGE SALES ESTABLISHED BY CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY CODE; AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE CITY PARK FOR PARTICIPANTS; PROVIDING THAT ALL OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS AND CITY REGULATIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT; AUTHORIZING PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE EVENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Frost regulates temporary uses, including garage sales; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to encourage community participation by providing residents with an opportunity to conduct a coordinated Citywide Garage Sale Weekend; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that waiving the individual garage sale permit requirement and exempting participation from the annual garage sale limitation for one designated weekend serves the public interest while preserving all other applicable City regulations; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is intended solely to authorize the October 2026 Citywide Garage Sale Weekend and shall not be construed as a permanent amendment to Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FROST, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Citywide Garage Sale Weekend.

The City Council hereby designates **Friday, _____, through Sunday, _____, October 2026**, as the official **Citywide Garage Sale Weekend** for the City of Frost.

Section 2. Limited Waiver.

For the Citywide Garage Sale Weekend authorized by this Resolution, the requirement to obtain an individual garage sale permit under **Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances** is hereby waived.

Section 3. Annual Garage Sale Limitation.

Participation in the Citywide Garage Sale Weekend shall **not** count toward the maximum number of garage sales otherwise permitted annually under **Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances**.

Section 4. Applicability of Existing Regulations.

Except as expressly provided by this Resolution, all other provisions of **Chapter 14** and all other applicable provisions of the City Code remain in full force and effect, including regulations governing signage, hours of operation, traffic safety, and the obstruction of streets, sidewalks, and public rights-of-way.

Section 5. Use of City Park.

Residents participating in the Citywide Garage Sale Weekend may utilize available areas within the City Park on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to all City rules governing the use of public property.

Nothing in this Resolution waives any permit, license, or approval otherwise required under federal, state, or local law, including any requirements applicable to the sale of food, beverages, or other regulated goods or services.

Section 6. Public Notice.

The City is authorized to publicize the Citywide Garage Sale Weekend through the City's website, social media, and other appropriate communication channels.

Section 7. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
