3. Citizen's Comments. (Time limit 4 minutes per person).
4. Discuss and Approve David Alexander request for a Zoning Change from Single Family Residential to Manufactured Home.
5. Discuss and Approve Elbert Butler as Fire Chief and Brian Catton as Assistant Fire Chief for the Frost Volunteer Fire Department.
6. Discuss and Approve possible further involvement with the Frost Volunteer Fire Department concerning management and financial assistants.
7. Adjourn.
