

3. Budget Workshop.
4. Discuss proposed new water rates.
5. Discuss proposed new property tax rates.

7. Adjourn.

NOTE: Pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Section 551 (Sections 551.071 – consultation with counsel on legal matters; 551.072 – deliberation regarding purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property; 551.073 – deliberation regarding a prospective gift; 551.074 – personnel matters regarding the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; 551.076 – implementation of security personnel or devices; 551.087 – deliberation regarding economic development negotiation; and/or other matters as authorized under the Texas Government Code), one or more of the above items may be considered in Executive Session closed to the public. If a Closed or Executive session is held in accordance with the Texas Government Code as set out above, the City Council will reconvene in Open Session in order to take action, if necessary, on the items addressed during Executive Session.
