\$250.00(OWNERS)/\$300.00(RENTERS) DEPOSIT MUST BE PAID BEFORE WATER IS TURNED ON. If you transfer water service, you must pay the difference in your previous deposit amount and the deposit amount due on the transfer date.

The City of Frost enforces the date bills are due for city services by disconnecting water service for non-payment. Bills are mailed about the 25th day of the month, and are due the first of the next month. A \$20.00 late fee is added to all not paid by the 10th day of the month, and a past-due notice is mailed stated that water will be disconnected if not paid by the 25th day of the month. A final notice is posted on the door reminding those not paid by the 25th day of the month that water will be disconnected and a \$25.00 reconnect fee is due, and the amount of the current water deposit in effect on the disconnect date shall be paid before water service is restored or water is turned on again, plus the delinquent water bill must be paid in full.

Set TRASH by street by 7:00 a.m. each Monday, in designated Republic trash carts.

DOGS may not run free. DOGS must be on a leash or secured in the yard so they may not escape.

PETS are required to have proof of current rabies vaccination per state and local laws.

VEHICLES must, at all times, be registered and inspected or owners may be fined \$261.00 per day.

MOWING must be done regularly to keep grass and weeds low.

WATER SERVICE INSPECTION AGREEMENT

The City of Frost is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution which could result from improper plumbing practices. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the plumbing restrictions which are in place to provide this protection. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each customer must sign this agreement before the City of Frost will begin Service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has signed copy of this agreement.

The following undesirable plumbing practices are prohibited by State Regulations:

- A. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air-gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
- B. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
- C. No connection which allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
- D. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 8.0% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
- E. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2 percent lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.

The following are the terms of the service agreement between the City of Frost (Frost Utility Dept) and _____ (the customer) as required by the "The Rules and Regulations for the Public Water Systems", Section 290.480(III), as adopted by the Texas Water Commission, Water Utilities Division.

- A. City Hall will maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premises is connected to the Water System.
- B. The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other undesirable plumbing practices. These inspections shall be conducted by the Utility Department or its designated agent prior to initiating service and periodically thereafter. The inspections shall be conducted during the Utility Department's normal business hours.
- C. City Hall shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connection or other undesirable plumbing practice which had been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic inspection.
- D. The Customer shall immediately correct any undesirable plumbing practice on his premises.
- E. The Customer shall, at his expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Utility Department. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Utility Department.

If the customer fails to comply with the terms of the Service Agreement, the Utility Department shall, at its option, either terminate service or properly install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement shall be billed to the customer.

ORDINANCE NO. 309

PLUS VOLUME RATE:

1,001 – 2,000 Gallons:	\$10.00 / Thousand Gallons
2,001 – 7,000 Gallons:	\$12.75 / Thousand Gallons
7,001 – 10,000 Gallons:	\$13.51 / Thousand Gallons
10,001 Gallons and Above:	\$20.69

ORDINANCE NO. 310


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE, CHAPTER 13, UTILITIES, SECTION 13.04 PARAGRAPH 006, INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONTHLY SEWER FEES, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, more income is necessary to cover the regular expenses of wastewater treatment operation.

NOW THEREFORE, the monthly sewer fees are now increased by an additional \$1.00 per base and additional .25 cents per 1,000 over 2,001 gallons, effective on monthly bills received near the end of October 2019:

BASE RATE (includes 0 – 2,000 gallons)	\$21.00
2,001 gallons and above	Base + \$2.75 per 1,000 gallons

BE IT ORDAINED, the above ordinance is adopted by City Aldermen this 7th day of October, 2019

ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF FROST, CHAPTER 6, HEALTH AND SANITATION, SECTION 8 PARAGRAPH A, ON OCTOBER 1, 2017 THE CITY OF FROST HAD ENTERED INTO A DISPOSAL CONTRACT WITH ALLIED WASTE SYSTEMS DOING BUSINESS IN TEXAS AS REPUBLIC SERVICE, AND ACCEPTING THEIR RATES

WHEREAS, the contract that the city entered into with Republic Service, original contract dated October 1, 2017, expires September 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, the contract contains a modification to rates clause that allows the contractor to increase or decrease fees imposed,

WHEREAS, Republic has increased their rates an average of 2.9%.

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Frost has increased the trash rate. The following rate adjustment for trash service are effective immediately.

WHEREAS, the City Council found it beneficial to amend the ordinance for Juvenile Curfew,


